Training Opportunities at Each Location

Phil Hardberger Park

Practice loose leash walking on trails and engagement when other dogs pass. Ask your dog for check-ins during walks.

McAllister Dog Park

Work on calm entries and exits. Practice calling your dog away from distractions before allowing them to greet other dogs.

Eisenhower Park

Great for confidence building. Practice structured hikes where your dog follows your pace and checks in frequently.

Brackenridge Park

Busy environments help teach neutrality. Practice ignoring joggers, bikes, and other dogs while staying focused on you.

The Pearl Farmers Market

Excellent socialization opportunity. Work on calm walking through crowds and settling next to you while you sit.

River Walk Morning Walks

Use the environment to practice leash manners and engagement around people, smells, and city distractions.

San Antonio Botanical Garden

Great for calm exploration. Practice slow walking and relaxed behavior in a peaceful environment.

Dog Friendly Hiking Trails

Practice structured adventures where your dog learns to stay with you instead of pulling ahead or wandering.
